

## BEGolf Scholarships

### Professional Scholarships

General criteria for receiving a scholarship:

- Former Belgian Team Player
- Integrated in the scholarship programs of AFGolf or Golf Vlaanderen
- A maximum support of 3 years

Financial aid is based on rankings and is an addition to the financial aid of AFGolf and Golf Vlaanderen.

- It's mandatory to hand in receipts/invoices to receive the scholarship.
- A yearly evaluation will be made in collaboration with AFGolf and Golf Vlaanderen.
- Professional players can benefit from invites on the Challenge Tour and LETAS
- A player receiving a scholarship can be asked to join a BT training (if possible, with the tournament schedule).
- The support can come to an end before the maximum of 3 years if a player is self-sufficient on the ET or LET or when the player is not making any progress.

### Amateurs turning professional midyear:

\* An amateur can get a one-time financial aid of € 750 (ET/LET) or € 500 (Satellite Tour) for playing the qualifying school (noncumulative).

\* Final WAGR at the time of turning professional.

\* Turning professional midyear does not count towards the maximum support of 3 years.
