

Amateur Scholarships 2025

Amateur Scholarships & Performance Allowances

Players from the Belgian Team can benefit from a **scholarship** depending on their WAGR ranking. The scholarship can be used for a tournament or a training session.

Criteria Ladies:

- WAGR Top 150 – Max € 2.500
- WAGR Top 300 – Max € 1.000
- WAGR Top 450 – Max € 500

Criteria Men:

- WAGR Top 200 – Max € 2.500
- WAGR Top 400 – Max € 1.000
- WAGR Top 600 – Max € 500

There is an overall age limit of 23 years, but exceptions can be done depending on goals and objectives of the player.

The position on the WAGR on the Wednesday of the 2nd week of January will count towards the criteria. Any changes afterwards will not affect the predesignated amount. If a player without a scholarship meets the criteria on the Wednesday of the 2nd week of July, he or she will be allowed to request 50% of the scholarship.

If a player turns professional midyear, he or she will get 75% of the scholarship.

An **allowance** of € 500, with a maximum of €2.000/year, will be given to a player making the cut at a tournament with a WAGR Power Level higher than 300. There is no allowance for Belgian competitions or during Belgian Team selections. Any scholarship and allowance will only be distributed after presentation of travel costs, hotel bill, etc.

BT 4GD

A player can receive a scholarship at the beginning of the year depending on their WR4GD Gross Ranking. The scholarship can be used for tournaments or a training session.

Criteria:

- Belgian Nationality
- Top 20 on the WR4GD Gross Ranking
- Attitude and motivation
