



Soudal Open Invites Regulations 2026*

1. Rules of attribution of 6 invites for Belgian Professionals

A **National Ranking** will be created based on prize money of 2025 & 2026.

Tournaments from the following professional tours will count towards the ranking: PGA Tour, DP World Tour, LIV Golf, Korn Ferry Tour, HotelPlanner Tour, Pro Golf Tour, and ALPS Tour. Additionally, the BeNeLux Trophy and the RPGAB Championship (organized by the Royal PGA of Belgium) and the Omnia Classic of Belgium (organized by the RBGF) will also count towards the ranking.

1. Players holding a PGA Tour, DPWT, LIV, Korn Ferry Tour or HotelPlanner Tour category for 2026, not otherwise exempt, who are in the top 25 of the national ranking will receive an automatic invite to the Soudal Open 2026. With the maximum of 6 invites based on the ranking.
2. Other invites will be allocated according to the national ranking order.
3. The player must be a full active Belgian professional competing on an international tour in 2026.

The invites will be allocated on the 30th of April 2026.

2. Rules of attribution of 3 invites for Amateurs

1 invite attributed to the highest ranked available Belgian amateur inside the top 500 on the WAGR of 29/04/2026. This spot will become a wild card if no player is available from inside the top 500.

1 wild card at the discretion of the Royal Belgian Golf Federation.

1 wild card at the discretion of Rinkven International Golf Club, the hosting club.
